

# IN SOLIDARITY WITH NURSES

We stand in solidarity with 20,000 NYSNA nurses at New York City private hospitals whose contracts expired on Dec. 31, 2025. Labor is in strong solidarity with these nurses who have been fighting for safe staffing, workplace safety, and fair wages and benefits.

We call on hospital administrators to listen to the nurses' demands and commit to a fair contract that protects patient care—with staffing and healthcare services for our communities, protections for vulnerable patients, workplace violence protections, safeguards on the use of artificial intelligence in healthcare, and fair wages and benefits to recruit and retain nurses. Hospitals should stop retaliating against nurses for raising patient safety issues, surveilling nurses' union activity and threatening RNs who exercise their union rights.

Unions are ready to stand shoulder to shoulder with nurses on the picket lines, if a strike becomes necessary. It's time for hospital administrators to listen to your nurses and commit to fair contracts for our communities and working people without further delay.
