



UPDATED Procedure for Submitting NYSNA Convention Resolutions

This year, NYSNA has updated the procedure for Convention delegates to submit proposed resolutions for the 2026 NYSNA Convention. **All proposed resolutions must now be submitted online, using this form: bit.ly/conventionresolutionform.**

Please keep the following in mind:

- Resolutions must have the support of at least 25 members from the bargaining unit or membership category the delegate represents (or 5 members if the bargaining unit membership or membership category is less than 50) in order to be considered by the Resolutions Committee and to be presented for consideration at the Convention.
- We encourage you to discuss your ideas with your LBU leaders and colleagues and submit resolutions well before the deadline! This step will help you avoid many of the common pitfalls listed below.
- If you send your resolution as an attachment, a word document makes it much easier for processing.
- A resolution submitted after the 60-day deadline may only be considered by the Convention after all timely-submitted resolutions have been considered if two-thirds (2/3) of the delegates determine, without debate, that it was impossible or impracticable to have submitted the resolution in a timely manner.



The deadline for submitting proposed resolutions is August 26, 2026.
