How Federal Healthcare Cuts Will Impact New Yorkers

Access to Care:

1.2 million

New Yorkers will lose their health insurance

 Medicaid cuts and weakening of the Affordable Care Act (ACA) will cause
1.2 million New Yorkers to be newly uninsured. Visit Medicaid Matters to see impacts by congressional district.



- If you buy insurance through the ACA exchange, premiums will increase by an average of 50%
- The AFL-CIO estimates that premiums for workers with job-based insurance could soar by nearly \$500 a year for each person covered and nearly \$2,000 for families.

Extreme Funding Cuts:



New York is projected to lose \$13.5 billion in federal healthcare funding.



Hospitals are projected to lose \$1.4 billion statewide from federal cuts.³

- Hospitals will likely demand higher rates from private insurance to make up losses.
- Nearly 50 hospitals throughout the state receive 20% or more of their revenue from Medicaid. Public, safety net and rural hospitals will be especially hard hit by funding cuts.⁴

Service Closures:



Approximately 70 New York hospitals could be at risk of closure from federal Medicaid cuts.⁵

 Safety nets could lose nearly \$2 billion because of cuts to the Disproportionate Share Hospital Funding cap.⁶

Job Loss:



79,000 healthcare workers could lose their jobs

 The Fiscal Policy Institute estimates that nearly 79,000 healthcare workers could lose their jobs in New York, and hospitals could lose nearly 19,000 jobs.⁷
